During the 2020-2021 school year, your child may participate in different forms of assessment as regulated by the State of Ohio. These assessments are designed for your child to show what they have learned throughout the year. The results are used by the state to determine if your child is receiving an effective education. The following is a list of state testing that our building will be administering this year:

- English Language Arts and Math (Grades 6-10), Social Studies (Grades 9 and 11) & Science (Grades 8 and 10)
 - o March 22, 2021-May 7, 2021
- Alternative Assessment for Students with Severe Cognitive Disabilities (AASCD)
 - o February 2, 2021- March 19, 2021
- English Language Proficiency Assessment for the 21st Century (ELPA21)
 - o February 1, 2021- March 26, 2021

In addition to state mandated testing, we also use other forms of assessment as assigned by our parent company Concept Schools. These tests are often used as “practice” for the above mentioned assessments. Teachers use the data from these assessments as a guide to meet your child’s individual needs. The following is a list of assessments that will be given throughout the year:

- STAR: Norm-referenced assessment
- SAT: Grade 11 (Spring 2021)
